

CLIMATE JUSTICE by Bas Dickhoff

There is a great deal of evidence that human activity is altering the climate system. Increased greenhouse gas emissions are causing higher temperatures, increasing sea levels, and extreme weather events. These climatic changes raise a number of issues of *justice*. It focusses purely an ethical and political issue rather than purely on environmentally or physical nature.
